From 01 June 2015, the Department of Home Affairs in South Africa will require all passengers below the age of 18 years to travel with an Unabridged Birth Certificate. Parents travelling with children will be requested to provide an Unabridged Birth Certificate (including the details of the child's father as well as the mother) of all travelling children. This applies even when both parents are travelling with their children and it also applies to foreigners and South Africans alike. When children are travelling with guardians, these adults are required to produce affidavits from parents proving permission for the children to travel.
