GREEN FORESTS & BLUE LAKES Helsinki / Helsinki

9 days - Journey into Finland's Heart and Soul
 Taking this tour to the eastern parts of Finland is like taking a trip into the heart of Finnish identity. The Finns love their deep green forests, the rolling hills and the glittering lakes that cover most of this area. The importance of this national landscape was highlighted in Finnish art during the era of national romanticism. Painters such as Akseli Gallen-Kallela and Eero Järnefelt traveled, with great effort, throughout the country and brought these landscapes into the national consciousness. Finnish writers like Runeberg and Topelius enthused about the beauty of the region in their works.

This is also where the mythological history, in the form of songs, sung and re-sung through generations, was collected into the National Epic, the Kalevala, by Elias Lönnrot. It has been said that these mythical stories also inspired JRR Tolkien for his creation of Middle Earth. This tour also explores the Russian influences and Finland's war history.

GENERAL INFORMATION ON ICELAND

Reykjavik can be accessed a by direct flights from most Northern European cities and is a 3 hour flight from London.

Population: 340,000

Language: The country's written and spoken language is Icelandic, a Nordic language very similar to the language spoken by Iceland's first settlers. Icelandic is one of the oldest living languages in Europe. English and Danish are mandatory subjects in school.

Currency: The Icelandic monetary unit is the "krona" (plural "kronur") (ISK).

All major currencies can be exchanged at the airport, banks and currency exchanges. Visa and MasterCard are accepted almost anywhere, and ATMs are easy to find.

Electricity: Icelandic electrical standards are European (50Hz, 240 volts) so many North American electrical devices will require converts. Plugs are generally two-pin, so devices brought in from Australia will require adapters.
